Fremd High School. She wants to pursue a career in neurology. Gill will be attending the University of Southern California next fall.



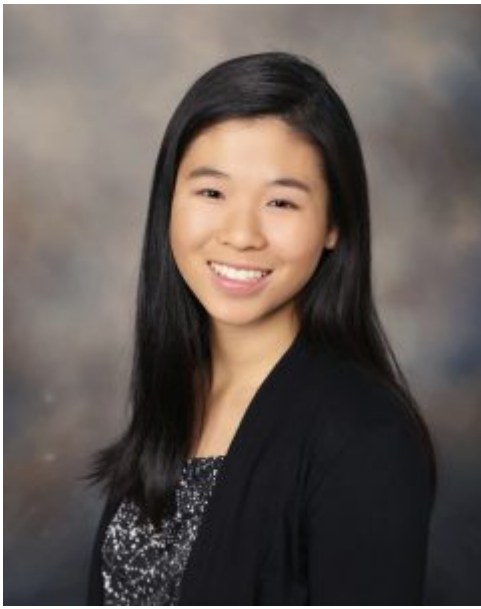
Stephanie Hu, a senior at
