Student musicians will perform during cocktail hour and Conant's Improv Troupe will perform before dinner. After dinner, the local band Flyte, which is composed of former Conant students, will perform and provide music to dance to. Additionally, there will be raffles and auctions. Among this year's raffle prizes is a three-day and two-night trip to Las Vegas, which includes a stay at a hotel of choice.
