

D211 POST: DISTRICT 211 NAMED ONE OF THE TOP EMPLOYERS IN ILLINOIS

Township High School District 211 has been recognized as part of Forbes’ annual list of America’s Best-In-State Employers 2020, with a ranking of 4th in the State of Illinois. The complete awards list was announced on August 24, 2020 and can currently be viewed on the Forbes [website](#).

Forbes and Statista selected America’s Best-in-State Employers based on an independent survey of approximately 80,000 U.S. employees working for companies employing at least 500 people in their U.S. operations. The surveys were administered using a series of online panels and provide a representative sample of the U.S. workforce. Direct and indirect employee recommendations were evaluated on a state level.

District 211 is one of the largest high school districts in Illinois with approximately 12,000 students. It employs more than 2,100 individuals, including faculty, educational support staff, operations & maintenance, transportation, food & nutrition services, and administrators in its five high schools, two alternative

learning facilities, and administration center.
